## General Information ~ 2016 Rates

The rental season begins on May 1<sup>st</sup> and ends on October 31<sup>st</sup>.

Spring and fall weekly rates range from \$650.00 to \$1,300.00.

Summer weekly rates range from \$1,200.00 to \$1,650.00.

The last week of June and August is from \$1,000.00 to \$1,400.00 per week.

Additional fees are an 9% Maine rental tax, a \$85.00 cleaning fee, and a refundable \$200.00 security deposit.

Half of the rental amount is due at the time of the booking and the remainder is due two weeks prior to your arrival. Your security deposit is refunded immediately upon inspection of the cottage.

I am getting set up for the 2016 rental season and I am really excited about it! My business continues to grow and I currently have 17 cottages that I manage the rentals for. Fourteen of them are at **Beach Dreams** in Wells, Maine. The picture to the left is one of my new cottages for this season which is right next door to another cottage I manage.
